

SURREY TREKKERS VOLKSSPORT CLUB (STVC) - PROTECTION OF PRIVACY POLICY

INTENT OF THE POLICY

STVC is committed to protecting the privacy and security of personal information. The intent of this policy is to govern how we collect, use, disclose and safeguard personal information.

COLLECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION

Personal information is information about an identifiable individual including, but not limited to, name, age, gender, home address, e-mail address, phone number etc. STVC collects some personal information from:

- Members
- Executive Committee and Managing Group members
- Volunteers

USE OF INFORMATION

STVC must only use personal information to advance its core purpose. The purpose of STVC is to:

- Promote physical activity and encourage members to enjoy the outdoors by participating in a family oriented, non-competitive sport;
- Plan and organize walking events;
- Keep members advised of Volkssporting activities by publishing a periodic newsletter and annual calendar of scheduled events in the Lower Mainland area;
- For phone calls and e-mails.

STVC is committed to using personal information in a respectful and useful way.

DISCLOSURE OF INFORMATION

STVC treats its obligations with respect to the use and disclosure of personal information very seriously. Generally, we will only use or disclose personal information for the primary purpose for which it was collected or for a purpose reasonably related to that primary purpose.

STORAGE OF INFORMATION

Personal information is stored in our database(s) on secure servers and/or in hard copy files. Contact information about a member will only be disclosed to the STVC executive. Contact information about a Surrey Trekker member will only be disclosed to another member if the Surrey Trekker member consents in writing.
